### About this organisation

#### Machine translation

This organisation has been machine-translated based on data provided in German.

The Research Centre for Gears and Transmission Systems (FZG) is an internationally renowned research centre for gears and transmissions at the Technical University of Munich (TUM). The research activities focus on the development of methods and reliable statements on the service life, efficiency and vibration behaviour of transmission elements such as gears, synchronisers, couplings, rolling bearings and transmission systems.

As part of various research activities at the FZG, lightweight construction solutions are being researched from model to system level. For example, alternative gear materials in the form of high-performance plastic gears or composite gears as well as tribologically more resilient tooth contacts through coatings or higher-strength material properties for plastic gears are being investigated at component level. In addition, the lightweight construction potential of additive manufacturing processes is being researched on these gears. The findings from the basic research are improving gear applications with higher power density and thus enabling lightweight system design. By investigating self-lubricated machine elements, the FZG is pursuing a promising new approach to operating lightweight transmission systems without external lubricant and the additional lubricant supply and sealing systems required for this.
